Session 1: TMF Board Matters

- 1) Announcements
 - a) Robin Park resigned her board position with a letter dated 9/14/17
 - b) Michelle Wilkinson resigned her advisory board position with a letter dated 9/15/17
 - c) Voted to pend election of new board member until later in the meeting
 - d) Decided to send written letter & plant to Robin. Standard letter has been sent to Michelle.

 - Jews/non Jews working together. Aleks participated. Steven’s role was consultant & philosopher. Ellis’s goal is to reclaim continuity of Jewish identity that was broken by Shoah
- Krzepice – John Mark
 - Met with teachers and Marek. Seeing transformation from community ‘helpers’ to leaders
- Nasielsk – Rachel, Przemek
 - Descendants, community, local activists. No matzevot so focus is on other things.

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Our role is to help develop cohesion and connect people to the community

- Award Ceremony (Krakow) – Steven, Przemek
 - Good networking opportunity
 - ‘Fractured Community’ issue well known
- Radomsko (Documentary) - Steven
 - Reconciling w/ past
 - Film almost finished & will be featured in Atlanta JFF
- Przerosl – Kevin
 - Descendants group with int’l reach
 - Prayer of Dead said by Cantor – very meaningful
 - Local historian – advocate for projects
 - Connecting present to the past – heart of our organization
- Piaski/Wawolnica/IHRA Project – Przemek, Elaine, Cindy
 - Experienced lots of uncertainty
 - We spent more time in servant role than in determining direction
 - Relationship always a factor
- Chrzanow – Steven
 - Continuation of IHRA Project
- Oswiecim – Jo
 - Relationships strong factor
 - Photo exhibit
 - Upcoming recognition for work in cemetery
- Rohatyn (Ukraine)- Steven
 - Will stretch us
 - Experienced heartfelt vision & passion Jay & Marla have
 - Steven’s shared ‘blueprint’ for a 2018 project he & Jay developed
 - Bringing back memory is exhausting
 - Catalytic, transformative agents – bring change/effect change
- Commemoration Project w/ FZ – Steven
 - Placed 28 commemorative matzevot – all w/n the ‘death corridor’ between Lublin & Lviv
 - Locations were in camps, forests, cemeteries, & hidden places
 - Very intense, not much time to debrief
 - Preemptive guerilla action – didn’t seek permissions first (key to seeing how people react to markers)
- Discussed how to document projects in a consistent manner & what to include. Jo to draft format that includes:
 - Details for analytics (Who, Where, When, etc)
 - Narrative
 - Pictures
 - Participant feedback (survey, quotes, feedback)
- We’ll stick to TMF swag for participants and do gifts/gift bags for partners, officials, etc as dictated by situation

- Cindy: Growth like a tree – roots & spreading branches, young people, descendants, “getting rid of the man-made gulf”
- Steven: Saw us make sacrifices, tree is producing fruit, 3 phases 1) March set up, 2) Early Summer & 3) late summer

Session 5 - Google Drive – John Mark

- John Mark created group folders to be used for TMF documentation so it's all in one place. He will add more folders as needed
- John Mark helped as needed so each person is comfortable with how to use Google Drive going forward

Session 6 - Structure – Board & Organization

We're doing work that is unseen (roots) and producing fruit that is seen

Voted to change board roles/titles

'Director of Community' role & title has been eliminated

'Director of Operations' title has been changed to 'Director of Operations US'

'Director of Operations – Poland' position has been added

Przemek was nominated for, accepted nomination for, and was voted in as Director of Operations – Poland

Staff Development vs board development

- We need to create a method for developing the organization & staff vs just the board

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- Will need to designate a director of staff
- Will need to differentiate between Admin and Operations
- We need to create distinction between volunteers (organization) and advisory board
 - Create definitions for each
 - Invitation letter(s) – Revise current Advisory document to be volunteer document

Polish NPO Status

International treaty gives us some status in Poland

Prof Jonathan Weber (founding member of Brama Grodzka, currently head of Jewish Studies at Jagellion University) – neutral on going solo, made suggestions

Partner with someone already there

Consider partnering with someone like Caroline

Consider partnering with Galicia Museum or Brama Grodzka

Functional Cooperation

Vehicle, business, Poland identity

Institutional partnership

In summary options are:

1. Go solo
2. Partnership
3. Cooperate with existing
4. No change

Considerations: Control, cost, maintenance, shared resources, limitations on what we do or who else we partner with, legal options & obligations

Best course seems to be to partner with an existing entity as a path to individual identity. If we take this route we would need a contract with clear expectations and time limit.

We'll need to be intentional in the way that we communicate to our other partners. (Most closely aligned, narrow focus, etc)

Przemek will investigate the legal differences between a partnership & being an independent entity
