I am writing with regards to proposed changes to the State Social Studies Standards.

I strongly support the restoration of Holocaust education to the 6th grade standard SS6H3b "Analyze the rise of Nazism and Nazi racial ideology through the use of propaganda, preexisting prejudices against target groups, and the incremental progression of events which lay the groundwork for the Holocaust."

I urge you to please reinstate the existing standard (SS8H9c) for 8th grade Social Studies. This Standard reads: "Explain the impact of the Holocaust on Georgians."

Understanding the Holocaust is a critical part of our children's education.
