I mention this for clarity: FODZ was *legally* established *by* and *for* the benefit of the Jewish Community of Poland in 2002. There may be others out there doing such projects, but they are not working for the direct benefit and at the express behest of the Jewish Community. I think this is important.

If you don't mind, then, I would please ask that the paragraph open along these lines, which I think can be simply stated:

"FODZ is the only institution in Poland that is officially dedicated to the task of....." (the rest stays the same).

Will that work for you too?

I love the addition of the memorial close-up.

Is it possible to broaden the **last sentence of the first paragraph - under the photo** - so it is not just limited to the cemetery in Zambrow?

For example, adding to the end, something along the lines that:

TMF and FODZ expect to partner on additional projects in Jewish cemeteries in Poland, as both organizations recognize the importance of these sites, not just for Jewish heritage, but also for town heritage.
